By submitting the entry form, everyone agrees to pay all fees indicated on the entry form. The closing date for entries stated in the announcement is binding in principle. Up to two weeks before the date of the first Futurity class, late entries are possible against payment of the late entry fee. The starter lists will be prepared for the next day 18:00 the evening before. Any changes regarding the exhibitor must be announced at the registration office by then, as the starter lists for the next day will be prepared and published. COVID 19 / CORONA

Due to the current situation regarding corona, it is essential that DQHA adheres to a hygiene concept in order not to endanger the health of all persons involved. This includes that currently only two accompanying persons per horse are allowed and that these must be stated when the horse is entered. Spectators are not allowed and all fees must be paid by Monday, 12.10.2020 - no cash payment on site!

As the situation may change before the show date, the DQHA will inform about any changes on its facebook page and the DQHA website.

Should it be necessary to cancel the tournament due to Corona, all fees already paid will be refunded.

DQHA FUTURITY CUP

Only American Quarter Horses whose sires have been paid into the SSA in the year preceding the breeding of the dam and who have also been nominated themselves are eligible to compete. For example, a foal born in 2019 is only eligible to compete if its sire has been paid into the SSA 2017 and the foal has been nominated for Futurity. You can find out whether the stallion was paid in at the DQHA office or at www.dqha.de. A further prerequisite is that the equine passport of the horse must contain an EU-conform breeding certificate. From the age of 3 years, the horse must also be registered in the DQHA studbook. Furthermore, the other conditions of participation of the DQHA rules and regulations for the SSA and Futurity/Maturity apply. The exhibitor and the owner of the horse according to the AQHA Certificate of Registration/Registration Application must be members of the DQHA. Note: The owner's DQHA membership must be equivalent to the registered owner on the AQHA Certificate of Registration/Registration Application. This means that for any partnerships, training stables, combined ownerships etc. the DQHA membership must be supplemented accordingly. This can be added to the family membership fee (€34) if a member of the partnership, training stables, combined ownership etc. is already a full DQHA member. The prize money is expected to be calculated

and distributed in 2021 and will therefore be considered retroactively in 2021 for the Leading Evaluation 2020. According to the AQHA Certificate of Registration/Registration Application, the breeder must be a member of the DQHA to receive his or her breeder's award. For participation in the Weanling Halter Classes, the following must also be taken into account: The classes are divided from 12 foals upwards (see DQHA Futurity/Maturity Regulations for division procedures). If the foal has not yet been registered with the AQHA at the time of entry, the fully completed Registration Application (copy) and a copy of the Certificate of Registration from the sire and dam must be submitted as a substitute. The exact date of birth must be entered. In the Weanling Halter classes, mares are not allowed in the hall, neither in the show ring nor in the preparation area! If the owner has a Futurity/Maturity free start voucher, a clear reference on the entry form is required and the original of the voucher must be enclosed. Not complete entries can be returned unprocessed. For the DQHA Futurity Cup, the DQHA Futurity/Maturity rules apply. The closing date for entries stated in the invitation is binding. Late entries are possible up to two weeks before the date of the first Futurity/Maturity class against payment of the late entry fee. Futurity/Maturity classes and the Champion of Champions will be judged according to the AQHA World Show point system. In the scored classes the scores will be added up, in the placed classes the points of the AQHA World Show key will be awarded and added up per placement. In the event of a tie, the respective tie judge will decide.

SHOW REGULATIONS:

The provisions of the current AQHA/DQHA Handbook as well as the DQHA Futurity/Maturity Rules and Regulations and the following provisions apply to the organization of the tournament:

1. The entry form must be received in time for the entry deadline - later entries will be regarded as subsequent entries.
2. By submitting the entry form, the competitor/horse owner acknowledges the announcement, the applicable show and data protection regulations and the hygiene concept and releases the organizer from any liability with regard to virus infection. Furthermore, he commits himself to pay the applicable fees.
3. The organizer reserves the right to change the announcement until the closing date for entries, to postpone the event or to cancel it and return the stakes if special circumstances make this necessary. After entry of the entries, the current schedule will be published in the media.
4. There is no contractual relationship between the organizer on the one hand and the visitors, horse owners and participants on the other hand. Therefore any liability for theft and injury to humans and animals is excluded. In particular, participants are not assistants in the sense of § 278 and § 831 BGB. Each horse owner and participant, as well as their accompanying persons and visitors, submits to the instructions and orders of the organizer and the show management when submitting the entry or entering the show grounds and accepts the rules of the AQHA and the DQHA.
5. The organiser is not responsible for late or lost mail, faxes or e-mails not received.
6. Every horse must have liability insurance. The horses must come from disease-free stocks and must be free of any notifiable disease. The vaccination regulations of the FN apply, see www.pferd-aktuell.de.
7. Entry fees and office charge will not be refunded after the entry deadline. Box fees will only be refunded on presentation of a medical certificate if the reserved box can be sublet (i.e. there are no more free boxes available).
8. Each participant will receive a confirmation of entry with the current time schedule before the start of the event. The participant is responsible for his punctual appearance at the starting time. The organizer has the right to start examinations up to 30 minutes before the time stated in the schedule.

9. Dogs must be kept on a leash on the entire show grounds (including the grass area). Free running dogs will be picked up and can be released for 100,- Euro at the registration office. Dog excrements are to be disposed of immediately by the dog owner himself - bags will be provided.

10. It is not allowed to ride or lunge on the show grounds without a valid start number. The whole area, especially the warm-up areas, will be checked for unsportsmanlike behaviour (see manual VIO200 and following).

11. To improve the fairness towards the partner horse, the official supervisors will be equipped with a camera to record disputed situations in sound and vision. These recordings are only used to clarify the facts of the case and may not be passed on to third parties. The recordings can be used as evidence in possible proceedings in case of unsportsmanlike conduct. Furthermore, the organizer reserves the right to use pictures from third parties. The participant has no right to claim the return of the recordings. With the entry the participant accepts these measures to improve fairness in equestrian sports.

12. By submitting the entry, the participant agrees that he/she will be photographed or filmed during the event and that the pictures will be published. Likewise, that personal data will be stored and published for tournament purposes.

13. The photo and video teams commissioned for the event have exclusive rights and no other photographer may offer his pictures of the event for sale. Private photos are allowed outside the arena.

14. Payment of cash prizes and refunds

The organizer is entitled to deduct any outstanding obligations of the participants. This also applies to the withholding tax according to § 50a Abs. 4 EstG for foreign horse owners. The following tax will be deducted from the cash prize: from 250,- Euro 15 % and plus 5,5 % solidarity surcharge on the tax withheld (tournament expenses will be credited). The tax deduction must be confirmed upon request. Foreign horse owners who are exempt from withholding tax can submit a certificate of exemption with their entry, at the latest on the first day of the event. Participants are responsible for the complete and correct entry of the required data.

15. Riders can only use equipment which is allowed according to the current AQHA/DQHA handbook on all riding areas. Exceptions: Mouth closer, ring martingale in combination with a snaffle bit, boots, wraps and fetlock boots. Horses must be lead on all other streets, ways or areas.

ILLEGAL MEDICATION AND DOPING

All horses participating in the Futurity Cup classes may be subject to medication/doping tests via blood and/or urine tests during their stay at the event. By signing the entry form, each exhibitor or horse owner agrees to have his horse tested for medication or doping by means of urine or blood tests. The FN Anti-Doping and Medication Control Rules for Equestrian Sports -ADMR- apply accordingly. (For more information, see www.Pferd-Aktuell.de).

In the event that a violation of medication/doping regulations is established:

- The exhibitor or horse owner bears the costs of the control and the proceedings.
- The horse rider combination is disqualified.
- All cash and material prizes are to be returned, placings will be disqualified.

The organizer reserves the right to take further disciplinary measures/sanctions against the horse/rider combination concerned or the horse owner.

The show commission appointed by the organizer consists of the show manager, the DQHA Futurity representative and the Futurity Manager. Substitute member is the chairman of DQHA Sports Committee. The Arbitration Commission determines the medication controls.

CLIPPEN & SHEARING

According to veterinary regulations clipped horses, especially in the area of the ears and eyes, as well as in the mouth and nuttern area, are to be excluded from the show. According to a circular of LANUV the clipping of foals for show purposes is forbidden on the basis of §16 a animal protection law. The organizer assumes no responsibility, liability or claims for damages for such cases, which must be excluded or cannot participate.
