AQHA's limited objective is to require "a level playing field" of competition. The designation "AQHA-approved show" means that if this show management fully complies with AQHA rules as contained in its "AQHA Official Handbook", AQHA will accept show results in Amarillo, Texas, as official and use such results to calculate year-end awards; and qualification for advancement of a horse in AQHA's breed registry, and other AQHA benefits.

As an express condition of the privilege to participate at an AQHA-approved show or event, and by participating, each owner of an American Quarter Horse, exhibitor, trainer, and employees of any of these individuals, and all other participants, assume the risk of participation, and release and discharge AQHA, its officers, directors, representative, and employees, from any and all liability, whenever or however arising, as to personal injury or property damage occurring as a result of participation.
