13 Point Penalties:

- Take or light turns of leg

Point Penalties:

- Tilting or rocking leg
- Out of line more than two strides from side of the center line and between markers
- Spilling the leg (leg between the two hind or two front feet at the 10s)
- Hitting legs (lapping or coming together during lead change)

3 Point Penalties:

- Not performing the specific leg (leg is used) or not stopping when called for the pattern with 10 feet (3 strides) in the designated area
- Simple change of leads
- Out of lead at or before the marker prior to the requested change except out of lead at or after the marker when the requested change area
- Additional lead changes anywhere in pattern (except when correcting an error in the pattern, points: 200)
- Pattern 1 and 2: failure to stop the horse within 10 feet (3 strides) after crossing the leg at the 10s
- Break or gallop walk or jog for more than two strides
- Break or gallop at the 10s

3 Point Penalties:

- Col at 10s beyond the next designated change area (not: failure to change, including cross-over leg; Two consecutive failures to change will result in one 3 point penalty)
- Steer avoidance including looking out, biting, kicking and rearing
- Hitting cattle with other hand
- Any other hand to itself face or place

Disqualification (DQ) or 0 Score:

- Bog equipment
- At 10s
- Off Change
- Knocking over markers
- Major refusal - stop and back more than two strides in front of the with hind legs
- Major disobedience or excessire
- Failure to start/stop prior to end zone in Pattern 1
- Four or more simple lead changes and/or four or more changes leads (except in Lead 1 and Rookie classes)
- Failure to start/stop beyond 20 feet of designated area in Patterns 2, 3, 4, 5 and Level 1 Western Riding Patterns 1, 2, and 4 (except for Level 1 classes)
- Cross-over of more than 10 s

MANEUVER SCORES

Each maneuver has a maximum value of 10 (10 points) and automatically begins the next with a score of 7.5 points
(Q = Quality, P = Poor, T = True, F = False, C = Correct, U = Uncorrect, E = Excellent)

10 Point Penalties:

- Trailing or tight lunge or leg

1 Point Penalties:

- Hitting or rolling leg
- Out of lead more than one stride either side of the circle point, and between markers
- Splitting the leg (leg between the two front or two hind legs) at the lope
- Hind legs stopping or coming together during lead change

3 Point Penalties:

- Not performing the specific gait (loge or lope) or not stopping when called for by the judge, with 10 feet (3 meters) or the designated area
- Single change of leads
- Out of lead at or before the marker prior to the designated change area or out of lead at or after the marker after the designated change area
- Additional lead changes anywhere in pattern except when commanding an extra change or increased lead
- Pattern 1 and 2: failure to start the lope within 20 feet (3 meters) after crossing the leg of the lope
- Break of gait at walk or jog more than two strides
- Break of gait at walk or jog more than two strides
- Break of gait at the lope

3 Point Penalties:

- Out of lead beyond the next designated change area (100' failure to change including cross changing. Two consecutive failures to change would result in two 3-point penalties)
- Elbow, shoulder or neck in charge would result in two 3-point penalties
- Holding saddle with other hand
- Loss of reins round to snaffle loose or loose

Dismountation (DSQ or 1 Score):

- Horse equipment
- WTB/Asse
- Off Course
- Crossing over markers
- Missed rail - stop and back more than two strides or four steps with 10' leg
- Missed cross-tie or activating
- Failure to start lope prior to end cone in Pattern 1
- Four or more simple lead changes or one failure to change leads (no leg for Level 1 and Rodeo classes)
- Failure to start lope beyond 30 feet of designated area in Patterns 2, 3, 4, 5 and Level 1 Western Riding Patterns 1, 2, and 4 (based on Level 1 classes)
- Out of lead more than 10' leg
